

WORSHIP MUSIC DIRECTOR

PURPOSE

To provide appropriate music (keyboard and/or otherwise) during services of worship.

ACCOUNTABILITY

Accountable to the Pastor as Head of Staff.

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. To plan, prepare and play music appropriate to each service or worship; i.e., prelude, interlude, postlude.
2. To prepare appropriate music for weddings and special services, (compensated and scheduled separately.)
3. To rehearse sufficiently for optimum performance.
4. To attend choir rehearsals for the purpose of accompaniment, (added compensation.)
5. To accompany congregation's singing of hymns/praise songs.
6. To accompany choir's singing of scheduled music.
7. To accompany soloists and/or ensembles.
8. To arrange for substitute when not able to be present.
9. To plan and prepare the praise set appropriate to each service.
10. To accompany the choir and arrange special music for the special services of the church year (currently Christmas Cantata Sunday, Christmas Eve, Maundy Thursday, and Easter Sunday), (added compensation.)

RELATIONSHIPS

This position is accountable to the Pastor as Head of Staff and the Worship Elder in the performance of his/her responsibilities.
